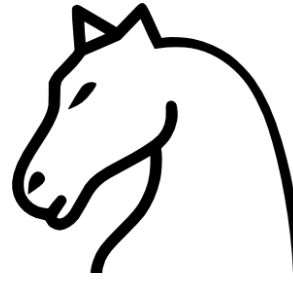


GOLDA CHESS TEAM CONTRACT

Because this activity is an after-school activity and it will require students to participate in chess tournaments away from the school, we will have a strict code of conduct for our team. This code will apply to behavior and expectations both in school, at home and in the community. In order to be eligible to stay after school and participate in the Golda Chess Team, students and parents will have to sign the below contract and agree to abide by the rules and consequences of this contract. This contract is designed to call our team members to a high level of responsibility and personal accountability. Please review the items in the contract carefully and discuss them with your child. following conditions/consequences in order to participate in the Golda Meir chess team:

All participating students:

1. Must attend a minimum of five (6) Saturday tournaments (fees must be covered in advance) to be eligible for State Championships in March. For planning purposes, tournaments usually last from approx. 8am to 4pm
2. Must attend Wednesday, after school practices from 3:00 pm until 5:00 pm on a regular basis.
3. Must be in good academic standing (No MI scores).
4. Must not receive more than 2 incident referral for any reason. More than 2 referrals will be grounds for dismissal from the team for the season.
5. Must represent themselves, their team, school and community with dignity and respect in team practice and tournaments. Respect towards all chaperones is mandatory.
6. Must abide by all rules established for in-school and afterschool activities.
7. Must participate fully in the chess team activities – this means playing chess.
8. Must act with graciousness and equanimity in the face of both loss and victory.

All participating parents:

1. Must be prepared to pick up their child/children promptly at 5:00 pm from Wednesday practice s and promptly from tournaments.
2. Must provide accurate and up-to-date contact information.
3. Must be willing and able to transport your child/children to and from practices and tournaments.
4. Must be able and willing to pay the one-time \$50 Activity fee (\$30 for siblings) and all tournament fees completely by designated deadlines.
5. Must provide child with money for purchasing food at tournaments or prepare food for their child/children to take to each tournament.
6. Must be willing and able to assist in chaperoning at practices and/or tournaments throughout the 2016-2017 chess season.
7. Must be willing to assist with planning and help the day of the Golda Meir chess tournament, Saturday, February 4, 2017.
